Montargis 4.II.1766–24.XI.1845
Miniaturist; oil painter, engraver and lithographer; friend of Girodet. Of noble origin, he is described as seigneur de Corquilleroy in some sources, and was an army officer before the Revolution. On his return from emigration he studied with Suvée but did not remain in Paris. The only known pastel is well into the nineteenth century.
