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REDMOND, Thomas

Breconshire c.1745 - Bath 1785 Portraitist in oil, pastel and miniature. Studied at St Martin's Lane Academy; exhibited at the Free Society (1762-66), the Society of Artists (1767-71) and the Royal Academy (1775-83). He worked in Bath from 1769, living in Orange Grove 1769-78 and Church Street 1783-84. The Bath chronicle for 11.X.1770 printed a notice of his marriage at St James's church to "Miss Jane Lawrence, niece to Mr Coward, lace merchant" (Leonard Coward was also pumper of the Baths); she died of consumption in 1781. The Chronicle for 14.VII.1785 reported his death:, "a man much esteemed in private life and highly distinguished for his ability as an artist." His four infant sons were appointed pumpers of the Baths shortly after.
