RICHECOUR, Graf von

fl. Vienna 1760–68

Le comte de Richecour paid 77 florins (with a comte Rouan) for lessons with Pierre-Joseph Lion (*q.v.*) during his stay in Vienna 1760–68. He was possibly the Austrian soldier and diplomat Charles-Henri-Dominique de Nay, comte de Rhecourt (Nancy 1730 – Florence 14.IX.1789), or Graf Rhecourt und Ney, later colonel of a dragoon regiment, son of Emmanuel-François-Joseph-Ignace de May, comte de Rhecourt (1694–1759), head of finance in Tuscany and a minister in Vienna.
