### RIVALZ, Antoine

Toulouse 12.III.1667–11.XII.1735

Painter and engraver, son of the architect and painter Jean-Pierre Rivalz (1625–1706). He studied in Paris from 1685 and in Rome between 1687 and 1702. His son Jean-Pierre, known as the chevalier Rivalz (*q.v.*), founded the Académie royale de Toulouse at whose salons several pastels by Antoine were posthumously exhibited. These were the only evidence that Antoine worked in pastel until the discovery that an anonymous pastel corresponded with a 1718 engraving of the portrait of Rivalz's wife. While there may have been a primary version of this portrait in oil, the technique, the subdued tonality and the characteristic folds in the fabric are what one might expect from Rivalz based on his known paintings and drawings.
