## **ROBERTS, James**

London 7.V.1753 – p.1809

Portraitist in oil, watercolour and miniature; pupil at the Royal Academy Schools from 14.III.1771 (aged “18 7<sup>th</sup> May next”); exhibited Royal Academy from 1773 to 1799. He was a drawing teacher in Oxford between 1784 and 1794. He is best known for his watercolour portraits of actors for *Bell's British theatre*.
