ROOYEN, Gabriel van

Utrecht 19.XII.1752 – Amsterdam 16.IX.1817
Also Rooijen. Dutch draughtsman and portraitist; pupil of Jan Augustini (*q.v.*) and his father Jacobus van Rooijen (*v. s.v.* Rooyen). He is recorded in Haarlem, 1770–71; Leeuwarden 1773 and Amsterdam from 1780 until his death. Several oil portraits are listed in the rKD files.
