ROSALIE, Mlle

f. Paris 1791

The various works sent by “Mademoiselle Rosalie” to the Exposition de la place Dauphine were for sale at her house, 48, rue des Fossés Saint-Germain l’Auxerrois (now the rue Perrault). Sanchez plausibly suggests that she is to be identified with the Mlle Rosalie Lebrun, Mme Vaysse, a pupil of Isabey who exhibited miniatures in the Salons of 1799 and 1800. The description of the 1791 exhibit, “demi pastel, en copie”, is unclear.
