Berlin 1737–1809

Decorator, draughtsman and portraitist; pupil of Blesendorf; member of the Berlin Akademie. Over 100 portraits were drawn for the Fürstbischof von Ermeland, in addition to portraits in oil and pastel. He engraved some 20 plates.
