fl. Berlin 1797–98

In addition to his exhibits, “Herr de Rouot” or “v. Rouot” submitted a Begutachtung von Pastellmalereien to the Berlin Akademie session of 14.1.1797. He was probably a French émigré, possibly a member of the family of Lorraine magistrates. A Nanine de Rouot was governess to the children of the Berlin doctor Ernst Ludwig Heim at the time.
