RONDOT, Louis-Joseph

Troyes 28.xi.1756–15.xi.1802

Maitre orfèvre (the son of an orfèvre graveur de la monnaie), procureur juge au tribunal, inspecteur général des postes. He worked for several years from 1781 in Paris in the workshop of Pierre Gouthière, the celebrated gilder and sculptor, returning to Troyes in 1783. As well as being a goldsmith he made numerous drawings, including it is said some in pastel.
