ROSENBERG, Johann Georg

Berlin 1739–1808

German printmaker and painter of military, landscape, architectural and theatrical subjects; portraitist in oils and perhaps pastel, possibly confused with his cousin Johann Carl Wilhelm Rosenberg (q.v.). Both seem to have studied with Fechhelm and Bibiena. It is unclear which if either was the "Jean Rosenberg, peintre de Berlin, agé de 22 ans" enrolled as a pupil at the École de l'Academie royale in Paris in .X.1765 (so born in 1743) under the protection of Wille.
