Bayeux 1713–8.x.1780

Also Ruppaly, Rupally etc. A painter in Bayeux trained by Restout. On 26.x.1733 he married Angélique-Louise-Hélène des Saulx. An anonymous copy after his self-portrait might conceivably have been an early work by his son, Gabriel Rupalley (*q.n.*).
