Daughter of John Russell, with whom she collaborated. In 1800 she married Robert Shurlock. According to Webb's scrapbook, the version of the warrener's boy in his possession was either the original, or a copy by Henrietta; Sée seems to have decided in favour of the daughter, although no other evidence of her skills is known.
