Saint-Lô 1778–1847

A pupil of Augustin (from 1796), Regnault and Aubry; 4, rue neuve du Luxembourg. He exhibited miniatures at the Salons from 1808 to 1839. His brother Martin Saint was also enrolled with Augustin.
