SAINT-JULIEN, Gräfin

fl. Vienna 1760–68

La comtesse de Saint-Julien paid 1444 florins for lessons with Pierre-Joseph Lion (*q.v.*) during his stay in Vienna 1760–68. Johann Joseph Graf Saint-Julien-Wallsee was Oberstküchenmeister at court; the pastellist was either his third wife, née Aloisia Franziska Gräfin von Thürheim (1732–1809) (her brother married Kaunitz's daughter), or his daughter from a first marriage, Maria Anna (1743–1798sa), herzoglich-savoyische Stiftsdame zu Wien.
