## **SCHÖNCHEN, Gottfried**

Arnhem 1740 – Munich 1816

Schönchen, Schöniche or Schoenche, was both pastellist and musician. He worked at the courts of Mannheim 1763–72 and, from 1779, Munich where he was Hofmusikus.
