SENAVE, Jacques Albert

Loo 12.IX.1758 – Paris 23.II.1823

Belgian painter of history, genre, animal and landscape paintings, as well as some and portraits. After initial studies in Loo, Dunkerque and Saint-Omer he enrolled in the école de l'Académie royale in 1778, under Dandré-Bardon, and was a pupil of Jullien and Suvée in Paris 1778–79. On 19.v.1789, at Paris, Saint-André-des-Arts, he married Marguerite Martin. He became directeur honoraire of the academy at leper in 1821.
