SEYFFERT, Heinrich Abel

Magdeburg 1768 – Berlin 1834

Self-taught artist, he produced portraits in oil, miniature and pastel, including of the royal family and leading aristocrats which he sent to the Berlin Akademie exhibitions from 1793. He also worked for the court in Schwerin. Nagler lists a second Heinrich Seyffert, probably a duplication. Although earlier miniatures are known, his work in pastel dates (with one exception) from after 1819 and are not catalogued here.
