STREICHER, Franz Nikolaus

Trostberg 1738 – Salzburg 1811

Pupil of Zoffany; he also trained at the Akademie in Vienna, becoming a portraitist in oil and pastel. He painted altarpieces in various churches in Salzburg, but is also known for portraits (some in pastel) in the museum and Chiemseehof palace in Salzburg. He taught the elder Lampi.
