According to the marriage application issued in Amsterdam on 10.VII.1750, he was from Brauschweig, 36 years old, when he married the 24 year old Hendrika de Raadt from Zutphen (she died in 1802, as his widow). He appears in Amsterdam church records as the father of children baptisted between 1752 and 1765. His last known work was a painting sd 1766.
