STURZ, Helfrich Peter

Darmstadt 16.II.1736 – Bremen 12.XI.1779

Writer and diplomat as well as portrait painter and draughtsman. Sturz (also Sturtz, Stürz) trained in Jena, Göttingen and Gießen, and was appointed private secretary to the Danish minister Johann Hartwig Ernst Graf von Bernstorff in Copenhagen in 1762. In 1768 he accompanied Christian VII on his visit to London and Paris. Some of the portraits he made around 1771 are in Hirschholm Slot. On the fall of the Bernstorff regime, Sturz was dismissed. He wrote a play; among other writings, his essay on capital punishment is noteworthy.
