STUTEN, Johann Moritz

Korbach 1720 – Berlin 26.II.1788

From Korbach in Waldeck-Frankenberg, he was a drawing teacher in the Ritterakademie and Cadeten-Corps in Berlin c.1770–90. He made portraits in miniature, oil and pastel, as well as history and genre pieces. He was possibly the Johann Moritz Stuten who married Anna Maria Leutlichen (the name variously transcribed) in Berlin, 20.IV.1751. He died 26.II.1788, aged 68, and was buried in the Evangelische Luisenstädtische Kirche, Berlin, three days later. Among their children was a son Christian Friedrich, baptised in Berlin, 26.XI.1764, and two daughters (*v. Mlle Stuten*).
