SWAGERS, Mevr. Frans, née Élisabeth G. Méri

Paris c.1775–1837

Painter, draughtsman and miniaturist; pupil of Pajou, Labille-Guiard and Augustin; professeur de dessin at Écouen. She married the Dutch landscape and animal painter Frans Swagers or Zwagers (1756–1836) from Utrecht; they lived in Paris. Subsequently she taught drawing at the Maison d'éducation de la Légion d'honneur at Écouen, and set up her own drawing school. The Zuylen pastel may be a copy after La Tour; the uncertainty in the identification is exacerbated by the confusion over dates and ages and lack of clear resemblance with the likely candidates. Some chalk drawings and miniatures are recorded.
