Ireland 1684 – London brd 14.XI.1726
The history painter, engraver and illustrator spent sixteen years in Italy, first recorded in Rome in 1704 working for Sir John Perceval and the Earl of Shaftesbury. He died soon after his return to London in 1725, and "Henry Trench of Saint Giles's in the Fields" was buried at St James's, Paddington.
