TRINQUESSE, Louis-Roland

Paris 1745–c.1800

Gold medallist at the Académie royale in 1770; exhibited at the Salon de la Correspondance between 1779 and 1787, and at the open Salons of 1791 and 1793. Trinquesse is well known for his distinctive sanguine drawings of elegant young ladies; there is no convincing evidence that he worked in pastel.
