TUCCHI, Domenico

Urbino 1728 – Todi 1802

Domenico di Giacomo, known as Frate Apollonio. The painter was taught drawing in Rome by Stefano Pozzi and painting by Batoni. Interested also in architecture, his main love was the art of the miniature, which he exercised at the court of Naples until, in 1766, he became a Camadolensian monk. He died 36 years later in the hermitage at Todi.
