TEPLOV, Grigori Nikolaevich

Pskov 20.XI.1717 – St Petersburg 13.IV.1779 Григорий Николаевич Теплов. Of humble origins he was educated in Germany, and became secretary to comte Razumovsky. He ran the Academy of Sciences of which Razumovsky was titular president. He supported Catherine II's coup d'état. His polymathic interests included music and trompe-l'œil painting (an example is in the Hermitage). A single signed pastel, of his patron, is recorded, from the 1905 exhibition.
