Amateur. The name is untraced, and may be a missprint, perhaps for Vanderelst or even Vanderkleft: Henry William Vanderkleft obtained a patent in London for a walking stick containing a pistol, telescope, pen, brushes and "des instrumens de dessin", misspelled as Vanderlest in the *Journal des débats*, 15.XII.1814 (GB Patent, no. 3837, 17.VIII.1814; he was an oil manufacturer of 253 High Holborn, London, bankrupt in 1819 according to the *London Gazette*).
