VAN LOO, Jules-César-Denis

Paris 20.v.1743–1.vii.1821

Son and pupil of Carle Van Loo. Landscape painter; *reçu* 1784. The sole pastel attributed to him is unconvincing evidence that he used the medium; it has also been attributed to Vigée Le Brun. In 1885 it was catalogued as a copy after a painting by his father.
