VAN SCHUPPEN, Jacob

Fontainebleau 1670 – Vienna 1751

Agréé 1704; *reçu* 1704, he worked in Paris until he was appointed peintre ordinaire du roi at Lunéville in 1707. He left for Vienna at the end of 1712, but continued his association with the Lorraine court. He made some drawings in coloured chalks.
