The Hague c.1710 – Amsterdam 1763


Also Johan or Joannes; engraver and pastellist, active in The Hague until c.1750, thereafter in Amsterdam. He and Houbraken both engraved the van der Helst original of his pastels. Among his other engravings is his black chalk self-portrait of 1743 (Amsterdam, Stadsarchief).
