VINCENT, François-André

Paris 30.XII.1746-4.VIII.1816

History painter; pupil of his father François-Élie Vincent and of Vien (qq.v.), registering as a student at the Académie royale in 1765; grand prix 1768; agréé 1777; reçu 1782. Despite the size and versatility of Vincent's œuvre, there is no conclusive evidence that he ever worked in pastel, although his relationship with his partner Adélaïde Labille-Guiard (q.v.) would have given him every opportunity to explore this medium. (No doubt this is why George Williamson attributed to Vincent the pastel of Labille-Guiard which he had recently bought – was the same work sold in New York in 1931 as by Gardner?) Perhaps however he felt that he should not intrude in her field.

Cuzin's definitive catalogue raisonné (2013) includes only one pastel among the œuvres mentionnés; it is a part lot and its description may be unreliable; Vincent is the heading for the previous lot, which may perhaps not have intended to cover this. The portrait of Suvée noted by Ratouis de Limay is in fact by Labille-Guiard. Cuzin notes that an early chalk drawing (no. 412 D, Petit Palais, perhaps a portrait of the young Mlle Capet), executed with some of the tricks of a pastellist, is "tout à fait exceptionnel" in the artist's œuvre. A similar drawing (no. 417 D), engraved by Demarteau, seems to relate to lost encaustic by Vincent's teacher, Vien, engraved by François after an intermediate pastel by Marie Leszczyńska (qq.v.).

More recently Cuzin 2020 has suggested that nine of the sheets in grisaille pastel related to the *Histoire de la maison de Bourbon* attributed to Fragonard (*q.v.* for discussion).
