### VATTIER

JL. Carpentras 1744

Known only from this example – unless he is the Vattier who exhibited at the Salon de Saint-Luc in 1764 (a portrait of l'abbé Rameau tenant un livre de musique, presumably in oil). He was probably either Charles Vattier, maître peintre à Paris, Saint-Sulpice, who married in 1712; or his son, Jean-Baptiste Vattier, who was also a painter in Paris, and in 1739 married Claudine Girardon in Lyon (he was still alive when his daughter married in 1770). Both father and son produced oil portraits.
