VENNEVAULT, Nicolas

Dijon 1697 – Paris 1775

Also Vénévault. Académie de Saint-Luc, peintre en miniature, adjoint à professeur 1748; exhibited miniatures and landscapes in 1751 and 1752. He then joined the Académie royale, reçu 1752, and exhibited at the salons from 1753 to 1767. In 1763 he became an associé de l'Académie de Dijon. His widow Julie-Anne-Claudine Perot died in 1784.
