WEYLER, Mme Jean-Baptiste, née Louise Bourdon, Mme Kugler

fl. Paris 1789–1810

Louise Bourdon was known as a miniaturist, enamllist and engraver, and according to Füssli made several pastels. She was a student of her first husband, Jean-Baptiste Weyler (*q.v.*), in Strasbourg. After his death she attempted to complete his series of *hommes célèbres*, but soon sold the collection. She exhibited in Paris from 1789, and by 1802 had remarried, exhibiting as Mme Kugler. She was listed as a painter at the Sèvres factory in 1806.
