WUNDER, Wilhelm Ernst

Kranichfeld 1713 – Bayreuth 1787

Pupil of Rentsch; he received further training at the Akademie in Bayreuth, and was appointed Inspektor of the gallery by Markgraf Friedrich. He painted in oils; specialising in still lifes in the style of the Dutch golden period.
