WEIXLBAUM, Johann Matthias

Vienna 1752–1840

Also Weixelbaum, Weichselbaum; Matthias or Michael (a miniaturist, Michel Weixlbaum (c.1790–1824), is presumably a relative). Pupil of Füger at the Akademie in Vienna; known as a miniaturist and a porcelain painter at the Kaiserliche Porzellanmanufaktur. He made portraits of the imperial family. Moritz Michael Daffinger was among his pupils. The only known pastel seems to show the influence of Johann Heinrich Schmidt (*q.v.*), who was in Vienna in 1775.
