### **BARNEWALL**

*The family of the attainted 10<sup>th</sup> Lord Trimlestown, an Irish peer, settled in Toulouse, founded a Masonic lodge, and were naturalised in 1745–46.*

⇒⇒ Nicholas Barnewall, 14<sup>th</sup> Lord Trimlestown (1726–1813) ∞ 1768 Marthe Henriette d’Aguin ou d’Aguin (–1782), fille de Jean-Joseph d’Aguin, baron de Launac (–1794), président au parlement de Toulouse

⇒⇒⇒ Rosalie Barnewall (1771–1864), pastelists ∞ 1795 Peter, Count d’Alton (1775–1851), of Grenanstown House, Tipperary, son General Edward d’Alton in the service of Maria Theresia

⇒⇒⇒ John Thomas, 15<sup>th</sup> Lord Trimlestown (1773–1839) ∞ 1797 Alicia Eustace (1773–1860)
