Piotr Branicki (c.1708–1762) ∞ Waleria Melania Teresa Szembek

⇒ Franciszek Ksawery Branicki (1730–1819), chev. St Stanisław 1774, chev. St Andrei 1774, great crown podstoli 1764, ambassador in Berlin 1765, great crown hetman of the Polish-Lithuanian commonwealth 1774–94 {*Lamp;*} ∞ Alexandra Katarzyna (Vasilievna) Engelhardt (1754–1838) {*Brompton*}
