### CHARTERIS

James Wemyss, 5<sup>th</sup> Earl of Wemyss (1699–1756), grand master of the Grand Lodge of Scotland ∞ 1720 Janet, dau. of Col. Francis Charteris (c.1640–1732), of Amisfield and Haddington, gambler and collector

⇒ David Wemyss, Lord Elcho, 6<sup>th</sup> Earl of Wemyss (1721–1787), Jacobite {*Bristish sch.*}

⇒ Francis Charteris, né Wemyss, Viscount Elcho of Amisfield, “7<sup>th</sup> Earl of Wemyss” (1723–1808) {*Bristish sch.; Ramsay; Reynolds*} ∞ 1745 Lady Catherine Gordon (–1786) {*Ramsay*}

⇒⇒ Francis Charteris, Viscount Elcho of Amisfield (1749–1808) {*Skirving*} ∞ 1771 Susan Tracy-Keck (1746–1835), amateur pastellist

⇒⇒⇒ Francis Charteris, 8<sup>th</sup> Earl of Wemyss and 4<sup>th</sup> Earl of March (1772–1853) {*Skirving*}

⇒⇒⇒ Lady Henrietta Charlotte Elizabeth (1773–1838) ∞ George Harry Grey, 6<sup>th</sup> Earl of Stamford

⇒⇒⇒ Lady Susan (c.1774–1816) {*Tonelli*} ∞ 1799 Sir Henry Clinton, lieutenant-general

⇒⇒⇒ Lady Katherine (–1863) ∞ Edward Richard Stewart

⇒ James Wemyss of Wemyss (1726–1786), MP {*Bristish sch.*} ∞ 1757 Lady Elizabeth Sutherland

⇒⇒ William Wemyss (1760–1822), lieutenant-general, MP
