⇒⇒ Frances ∞ 1765 William, Viscount Howe, KB

⇒⇒ Caroline (1755–1817) 2<sup>o</sup> 1770 ∞ John Hobart, 2<sup>nd</sup> Earl of Buckinghamshire (1723–1793spms), lord-lieutenant of Ireland 1776, FRS {*Hamilton*}  
[∞ 1<sup>o</sup> 1761 Mary Anne Drury (1740–1769dspm)]
