#### ELLIOT OF WELLS

William Elliot (–1728) of Wells in Roxburghshire, merchant of gold lace ∞ Eleanor N (–1745)

⇒ Eleanor ∞ 1702 Sir Gilbert Elliott, 3<sup>rd</sup> Bt of Stobbs (1681–1764), father of Lord Heathfield *q.v.*

⇒ William Elliot (1696–1764sps), of Wells, lieutenant-colonel, Horse Grenadier Guards, MP ∞ 1737 Lady Frances de Nassau d’Auverquerque (–1772)

⇒ John Elliot of Brugh ∞ Elizabeth Crispe

⇒ ⇒ William Nassau Elliot (–1775), of Reigate, barrister, commissary general to the forces of Germany ∞ 1764 Martha Tryphena Louisa Meade (–1796) {*Gardner*}, dau. of Sir Nathaniel Meade, Kt

⇒ ⇒ ⇒ Rt Hon. William Elliot of Wells (1766–1818sa), MP, chief secretary for Ireland

⇒ Charlotte (c.1692–c.1753) ∞ Major General Roger Elliott (c.1665–1714) of uncertain relationship to the Port Eliot branch

⇒ ⇒ Joseph Granville Elliott, comte de Morhange, dit comte Eliot de Port-Eliot (1713–1759), in service of Elector Palatine ∞ 1<sup>o</sup> 1735 Jeanne-Thérèse du Han, comtesse de Martigny (1707–1748); 2<sup>o</sup> 1750 Elizabeth Duckett

#### ELLIOT OR ELLIOTT OF STOBS

Sir Gilbert Elliott or Elliot, 3<sup>rd</sup> Bt of Stobs (1681–1764), MP for Roxburghshire ∞ 1702 his cousin Eleanor Elliott or Elliot, sister of William Elliot of Wells in Roxburghshire

⇒ Sir John Elliott, 4<sup>th</sup> Bt of Stobs (1705–1767) ∞ Mary Andrews

⇒ George Augustus Elliott, 1<sup>st</sup> Baron Heathfield (1717–1790), KB 1783, soldier, governor of Gibraltar {*M Brown; Copley; Hamilton; Köbler; Peart; Reynolds*} ∞ 1748 Pollexfen Anne Drake

⇒ ⇒ Francis Augustus, 2<sup>nd</sup> Baron Heathfield (1750–1813)

⇒ ⇒ Anne (1754–1835) ∞ 1777 John Trayton Fuller (c.1723–1811)

⇒ ⇒ ⇒ General Sir Augustus Elliott Fuller (1777–1857) {*Gardner*}
