Sir Thomas Frederick, Kt 1721 (1681–1731), governor of Fort St David, in the East Indies 1^o ∞ 1705 Mary Moncrieff (–1767) [∞ 2^o William Poynts]

⇒ Thomas Frederick (1707–1740sp), MP for Shoreham-by-Sea

⇒ Sir John Frederick, 4th Bt (1708–1783), inheriting baronetcy from his uncles, MP ∞ 1741 Susannah Hudson

⇒ ⇒ Sir John Frederick, 5th Bt (1749–1825) {*Russell*} ∞ 1778 Mary Garth (–1794) {*Russell*}

⇒ ⇒ Sir Richard Frederick, 6th Bt (1780–1873sa)

⇒ Sir Charles Frederick (1709–1785), MP, comptroller of ordnance 1749, KB 1761 ∞ 1746 Lucy Boscawen, dau. of Lord Falmouth

⇒ Charles Frederick (1748–1791), colonel

⇒ Mary {*Hoare*} ∞ 1733 Alexander Hume (c.1693–1765spm), MP for Southwark, director of the East India Company 1737–48, acquired estate of Wormley Bury 1739 {*Hoare*} *q.v.*

⇒ Henrietta ∞ 1746 Luke Spence

⇒ Hannah ∞ 1746 Sir Abraham Hume, 1st Bt (–1772) *q.v.*
