⇒⇒ William Geekie (1690–1767), of St John’s College, Cambridge, DD 1729, fellow of Queen’s College, chaplain to the Duke of Somerset, archdeacon of Gloucester *{Kneller}*

⇒⇒ Alexander Geekie (1693–p.1739), surgeon, of Pall-Mall, bankrupt in 1737 ∞ Anne Alden, daughter of Charles Alden, embroiderer

⇒⇒ Jane (1694–1780) 2<sup>d</sup> ∞ Canterbury 1751 Venerable Sir John Head (1701–1769), 5<sup>th</sup> Bt, DD, archdeacon of Canterbury, rector of Ickham [∞ 1<sup>o</sup> Mary Leigh (1713–), dau. of Rev. Peter Leigh & Elizabeth Egerton]
