Susannah White (1676–1751), dau. of Samuel White, merchant & sister of Mary, Lady Wittewrong

⇒ Anna Maria Gumley (c.1696–1758) ∞ 1714 William Pulteney, 1st Earl of Bath 1742 (1684–1764sps) {*Jerrus; Kneller; Ramsay; Reynolds*}

⇒ Mary Gumley (1693–) ∞ Francis Colman, diplomat in Florence

⇒ George Colman (1732–1794), dramatist

⇒ Samuel Gumley (c.1698–1763), lieutenant-colonel, 1st Foot Guards, MP for Hedon 1746–47 2^o ∞ 1751 Martha Degge (1711–1787) {*Russell*} ∞

[1^o Robert Colvill (1702–1749sp), MP for Killybegs 1719 *q.v.*]

⇒ John Gumley (–1743), chief of Dacca, India 1^o ∞ Martha Wittewrong (c.1701–1748) [∞ 2^o Edward Eyles, council at Fort William, Calcutta]

⇒ Laetitia Gumley (–1760) ∞ 1735 Lancelot Charles Lake

⇒ Gerard Lake, Viscount Lake (1744–1808), general, equerry to Prince of Wales, MP
