⇒ Caesar Hawkins (–1806), captain, 8<sup>th</sup> Light Dragoons

⇒ Louisa Anne (–1840) ∞ 1801 Thomas Truesdale Clarke (1774–1840), of Swakeleys

⇒ Rev. Edward Hawkins (–1805) of Bisley
