## **BARBET, Mlle**

*fl.* Toulouse 1779–81

Pupil of Sabère. In 1779 she was awarded a prize by the Académie de Toulouse for an unspecified work. She may have been a daughter of Jean Barbet, maître en chirurgie in the city: Jeanne-Marie-Victoire was baptised at La Daurade, 29.XI.1760; she married François Pouzens in Toulouse on 30.IX.1783. (Her sister Julie died aged 8.)
